Common practices include: short-term loans at rates that may exceed 500% APR; expensive and unnecessary insurance sales; auto sales that charge exorbitant interest on already-overpaid vehicles; real estate "deals" that result in high rates of foreclosure; and worthless "work-at-home" offers. 
