H. Tubman: Brigadier General

Harriet Tubman (1823-1913) was posthumously awarded the rank of Brigadier General by the Maryland Army National Guard on November 11, 2024. Abolitionist Harriet Tubman was the first women to oversee an American military action during a time of war. Tubman is known for establishing the underground railroad. She channeled those experiences to be a scout, spy, and a nurse for the Union Army during the Civil War, helping guide 150 Black soldiers on a gunboat raid in South Carolina.

Flag City Honor Flight

Helen Wheeler (USAF) was one of three female veterans on the September 10, 2024, Honor Flight to Washington. While at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier she was able to see three wreath-laying ceremonies which offered a moving memory for all the veterans in attendance. The Mirror (11/8/24) quoted Wheeler as saying "I believe that being in the military made me a stronger person, and one who was willing to go to war for our country. It also taught me about teamwork. September 10th marked the 28th mission of Flag City Honor Flight taking veterans to Washington, D.C. This equates to 2,000 veterans experiencing a day in the capitol. WVI would like to encourage women veterans to apply for an Honor Flight. Applications can be found at flagcityhonorflight.org. The 2025 dates are not available currently.
